



Sequence markers:

In the beginning: First – Firstly - To begin with - At first - In the beginning - Initially - As a starting point - before anything

Middle / Steps: Then - Next - After that - Secondly / Thirdly / etc. - In the meantime - Following that - Meanwhile — Subsequently - At this point - As soon as



Sequence markers

Ending: Finally – Lastly - In the end – Eventually - At last, To conclude - To sum up - As a final point - In conclusion.

Non-strict Time Markers: Afterward – Thereafter - All of a sudden – Suddenly – Once - At that moment - By the time - From then on



Notes

- You shouldn't use advanced vocabulary all the time. Prioritize simplicity and avoid repetition.
- Even if a word has synonyms, their use cases and sentence structure are not the same. It's advised to search for examples and practice before using in real-time.
- Writing academically doesn't mean sounding like a robot. Be natural. Be you. But in a more formal way.
